PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

The City of Bakersfield's Home Accessibility Grant Program provides grants for housing modifications designed to provide or improve access to disabled home owners or renters. The assistance is provided to those persons who have permanent physical challenges and are mobility impaired. This program is intended to promote independence at no cost to HUD qualified applicants by modifying their homes.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Limited grants up to \$3500 (non-repayable funds) are available for residential accessibility related modifications for qualified residents in the City of Bakersfield.

Program Eligibility

Home Accessibility Grants will be available City-wide to those persons who are assessed as physically challenged and mobility impaired by their physicians.

All Residents whether living in single family or multi-family dwelling units must first obtain property owner's consent in writing to complete .

Household must be at or below 80%.of Area Median Income as published by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD).

INCOME ELIGIBILITY

Eligible home owners or renters *must* meet the following income requirements, set by HUD annually. Annual household income cannot exceed the amounts below:
