- YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 14 ½ (IN HIGH SCHOOL) TO 20 YEARS OF AGE
- YOU MUST HAVE A GENERAL INTEREST AND APPRECIATION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
- YOU MUST HAVE AND MAINTAIN ACCUMULATIVE G.P.A. OF 2.0 ("C" OR BETTER IN EACH CLASS)
- YOU MUST NOT ENGAGE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUGS
- YOU MUST BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER
- YOU MAY NOT HAVE ANY FELONY CONVICTIONS
- IF UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE, YOU MUST HAVE PARENTAL CONSENT AND SUPPORT
