The Bakersfield City Council is recruiting individuals to serve three (3) year term on the **Historic Preservation Commission**, due to the term expiration of Cheryl Long on March 30, 2020.

Members of the Historic Preservation Commission are nominated and appointed by the full Council. Members must be residents of the City, however not of a specific Ward, throughout their 3-year term (Municipal Code §15.72.040). The Historic Preservation Commission reviews applications for cultural resource designations and historic districts; presides and conducts public hearings on designation applications; and makes recommendations to the City Council. Additionally, the Commission reviews and comments on applications as may be referred to the Commission by the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Adjustment or the City Council. Applicants are advised that a Statement of Economic Interests (F.P.P.C. Form 700) and a Health and Safety Code Section 33130 California Redevelopment Law Disclosure Statement will be required upon assuming office.
